
Connect Rocket to your game system Xbox 360, Xbox One, PC, WiiU, PS4

Plug in a USB thumb drive



You can connect a microphone to record game commentary. The Rocket will accept powered or unpowered micro-

phones, as long as they have a 3.5mm microphone jack.





Start recording

Check to make sure the Green LED on the front of Rocket is on. This means you are ready to record.

Then click the red **Record** button to start recording. Click again to stop recording.



Wait until the Red record ring stops flashing before removing the USB thumb drive.

HD PVR Rocket records video in MP4 format, which is compatible with iMovie for the Mac and Sony Vegas on a PC, plus many other popular editing applications.

Download and install Hauppauge Capture on your PC

To use the HD PVR Rocket to record, edit and upload your game play on a Windows -PC, you will need to install the Hauppauge Capture application on the PC where you will be recording.
